Assembly Bill 239

Assembly member Mark DeSaulnier has introduced Assembly Bill 239 to regulate the profession of alcohol and drug counselors in the private sector in California. This bill provides for the licensing of alcohol and drug treatment counselors by the Board of Behavioral Sciences within the Department of Consumer Affairs. The Justin Foundation fully supports this legislation as it pertains to the private sector and encourages the State of California to enact further legislation to protect the consumer of AOD services in the public sector.

The Justin Foundation celebrates all organizations, providers, administrators and staff members who offer reputable evidence-based substance abuse treatment services in California – of which there are many. The Justin Foundation believes that all patients should have the opportunity to be in a SAFE environment to heal from substance abuse and the State of California has an obligation to protect the consumer. We are hopeful that Assembly Bill 239 will be passed to achieve this end.
